

Directions: Start by painting the child's hands in 5 different colors; one color from tip of finger down to base of palm so that you have 5 stripes of color when finished: red on pinky, orange on ring finger, yellow on tall man, green on pointer, and blue on thumb. Work quickly so that the paint won't dry. Stamp the child's hand on one corner of thick paper, at an angle pointing inwards. Repeat with the child's other hand and stamp it on the other bottom corner. When the handprints are finally dry, gather 5 pipe cleaners in red, orange, yellow, green, and blue. Carefully poke the ends of the pipe cleaners through the paper at the tips of the matching fingerprints and gently pull any extra through the back until you get an arc shape running from fingertip to fingertip. EASTER SNACK RECIPE

Materials:

- 1. Fruit juice
- 2. Easter Eggs
