- 1 Package each of colored chocolate candy melts
- 1 Package Vanilla Sugar Wafers
- Assorted Sprinkles



Directions: Melt about half of each package of candy melts according to package instructions. Lay out a sheet of parchment paper and dip each wafer into the chocolate. Place the dipped wafers on the parchment paper and immediately decorate with sprinkles. Allow to dry for a few minutes. Once dry, immediately place in an air tight container so that the wafers don't get stale. Enjoy!

Materials:

- Acrylic paints in white, pink, blue, and light blue
- 4 Spray bottles or spritzer bottles
- Tape or poster putty
- Water
- Black construction paper
- Paper and pencil
- Scissors
- Optional: White gel pen

Directions:

Prep your spray bottles by pouring a bit of each color paint into each bottle. Add enough water to each bottle so it sprays easily. Shake it well to mix. You should end up with four spray bottles of paint: blue, light blue, pink, and white. Help your child to trace his or her hand onto a sheet of paper and cut out the handprint. Attach the child's paper handprint to the black paper using rolled up single-sided stick tape or double-stick tape. Be sure the tape is completely under the handprint and not sticking out from any of the edges. Create a space to place black paper onto to spray paint. Spray your paper with the blue paint. Make sure to spray all around the handprint. Next use the light blue and then pink paint. Add any additional sprays of blue, light blue or pink that you want. Finish with a few sprays of white to look like the stars. Once dried remove the handprint. Write "I love your more than all the stars in the sky" in white gel pen.
