- Twine

Instructions

- 1. Start by laying out a piece of ribbon
 - and putting your scrabble tiles to spell the name. Leave extra space on top for the bow and to fold over.
- 2. Hot glue the pieces on the ribbon then the bow.
- 3. Tie a piece of twine in a circle and put through the top of the ribbon.
- 4. Fold over the ribbon and glue it down.
- 5. Glue on a string of bells in the back or leave as is!
