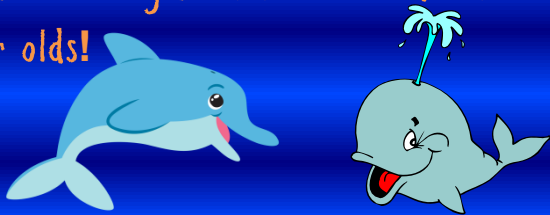
Confetti Poppers Craft

Materials: Empty toilet paper rolls, standard size latex balloons, scissors, hole punch, duct tape and construction paper.

Instructions:

Knot each balloon at the end. Cut balloon in half. Take the knotted half of the balloon and stretch it over the end of a toilet paper roll. Secure the balloon with a piece of duct tape. Decorate the toilet paper tube in any way you'd like. Next punch holes in colored construction paper to make confetti and fill the poppers. To use hold confetti popper upright and pull down on the knotted end of the balloon and let go.
