

Materials Needed:

- Paint (ROYGB)
- Pipe Cleaners
- Thick Paper
- Sponge Paint **Brushes**



Directions: Start by painting the child's hands in 5 different colors; one color from tip of finger down to base of palm so that you have 5 stripes of color when finished: red on pinky, orange on ring finger, yellow on tall man, green on pointer, and blue on thumb. Work guickly so that the paint won't dry. Stamp the child's hand on one corner of thick paper, at an angle pointing inwards. Repeat with the child's other hand and stamp it on the other bottom corner. When the handprints are finally dry, gather 5 pipe cleaners in red, orange, yellow, green, and blue. Carefully poke the ends of the pipe cleaners through the paper at the tips of the matching fingerprints and gently pull any extra through the back until you get an arc shape running from fingertip to fingertip. Then place art in frame! ©



EASTER SNACK RECIPE

Materials:


- 1. Fruit juice
- 2. Easter Eggs
- 3. Lollipop sticks
- 4. Large nail/thumbtack
- 5. Small funnel or piping tip to fill the eggs



Directions: First, tip the eggs upside down and poke three holes in the bottom. Two of these holes are for letting the air escape when filling the eggs; the third one should be in the center of the bottom. Make this center hole bigger using the large nail. It needs it to be as big as the popsicle/sucker stick. Once that is done, use the piping tip to fill each one until almost full, and then poke in the Popsicle stick and place in the freezer until firm. Remove from freezer and enjoy ©
