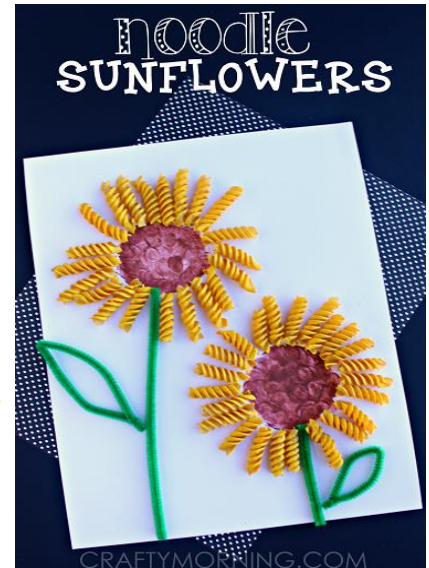




**FALL BREAK

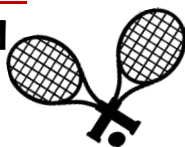
