



A Healthy Snack: Fried Honey Bananas

- 1 tablespoon coconut oil (olive oil works too!)
- 1 slightly under-ripened banana
- 1 tablespoon honey
- 1 tablespoon water
- 1 teaspoon cinnamon





Heat oil in a skillet over medium heat. Slice banana into about 1/4 inch thick slices. Fry bananas for 2 minutes on each side, occasionally lifting to prevent sticking. Whisk together honey and water. Remove pan from heat and pour honey and water over bananas. Top with cinnamon.


