SALT + WATERCOLOR snowflake art

Materials: Watercolor Paper, Watercolor Paint, White Crayons, Paint Brushes, and Table Salt.

Instructions: Cut watercolor paper into approx. 3"x4" pieces. Use the white crayons to draw snowflakes on the paper. You may need to help your kiddo with this part. Follow instructions on watercolor paint to mix with water in small containers. Brush watercolor paint over the paper and your snowflakes will appear. Cover your paper in water colors. Then sprinkle a little table salt onto your paintings while still wet (less is more).
